Good Samaritan Training School for Nurses

Rules and Regulations

- A. Home” Help to dignify our home by treating it as if it were our very own, and by observing the following precautions:
1. The home is to be quiet at all times, with the absence of loud conversation and laughing, the walls are not sound-proof, if fact, they amplify voices.
  2. No radios are to be played between 11 A.M. and 4 P.M., as night nurses must sleep.
  3. Student nurse are to keep their rooms clean; this includes neat and orderly closets and dresser drawers.
  4. Dust and refuse must bot be left in the halls at any time.
  5. Nurses re aske to pick up their feet while walking, and to avoid hard heels during quiet hours.
  6. Bottles and shoes are not to be swept along the floors as they make a terrible noise while rolling over the floor.
  7. Radios are to be played for the occupants of one room, and not for the entire home.
  8. Keep hopper room doors closed and do not sweep trash on the hall closet floors. Dust pans are provided to take up the trash, and cans to put it in.
  9. Be careful of your dress while walking through the halls during calling hours in the evenings.
  10. Avoid slamming doors are all times.
  11. No nurse is to talk out of the windows.
  12. Be careful of all lights and turn them off when not in use.
  13. Report burned out bulbs to the Superintendent immediately.
- B. Dining Room and Kitchen: Nurses are to come to the dining room in full uniform or as they would go in the street, and not in old, ragged dresses. Nurses are reminded not to argue with the help, but to settle all matters by reporting them to the proper authorities when arguments arise. In this manner the dignity of the nurse is maintained. Night nurses may get up for dinner on Sundays. Nurses should observe etiquette while eating and sit as ladies.
- C. Privileges:
1. All students are to be in the building by 5 P.M. until otherwise notified.
  2. Students must be in by 12:45 P.M. on Sunday for dinner.
  3. Probationers do not have to be accompanied by older students on their A.M.s and P.M.s
  4. Night nurses must go to bed by 8 A.M. Sundays so that they may go out at 2 P.M.
  5. Party hours shall be from 8 to 12 P.M. All company must be out of the building by that time.
  6. Calling hours:  
Freshman: 7:30 P.M. to 8:45 P.M. Sundays  
Juniors and Seniors: 7:30 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. Sundays

Seniors: 7:30 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. Fridays

Refreshments: One student may collect all orders and call for them in the office and wait for them before 8:30 o'clock.

Read these rules carefully and write them down if necessary as any privileges will be withdrawn at the discretion of the administration from any student who (1) fails in her studies, (2) comes to class with lessons unprepared, (3) Deliberately breaks any rule, (4) or grumbles and complains constantly.
